WHO MAY ENTER

Contest is open to legal residents of Greenville County, SC, who attend Kindergarten through 12th grades at the time of entry. Greenville County home schooled students are also eligible. You must have permission from a parent or legal guardian to enter the contest.

ENTRY FEES

There are no fees to enter the contest.

CONTEST CATEGORIES

Where Would We Beee Without Pollinators

This could include anything related to pollinators including (but not limited to) photos or illustrations of actual pollinators, their habitat, and anything that benefits from pollinators. It is up to the student to interpret the theme.

CONTEST RULES

Students may submit one image in each of the two categories.

Photos: Each student may submit one entry in the photography category. Photos must be the original work of the student submitting them. **Photo must be taken within Greenville County, SC.**

Illustrations: Students may submit one entry in the digital media category. Illustrations must be wholly the original work of the student artist.

Copyright: The photograph/illustration and the description must be a work of original material by the contest entrant. By entering the contest, entrant guarantees that the submitted artwork and description are original works created solely by the entrant and that no other party has any right, title, claim or interest in the photograph or the description.

Submission: Students should email a high-resolution image (must be at least 1600 pixels on the shortest side) image in .jpg, .png or .tif format to <u>contest@GreenvilleSoilandWater.com</u> with the subject line "2019 digital media contest". Entries must include participant's name, school affiliation and grade, and title of image, along with a 2- to 4-sentence description of the photo/illustration and location (if photo) in the body of the email. No printed artwork will be accepted. Please only send one photo per email. **Artwork must be submitted by 5:00pm on November 7, 2018.**

JUDGING AND PRIZES

A panel of judges will select a winner in each category based on the following:

- interpretation of the category theme
- creativity
- originality
- artistic expression

All winners will be notified by email by December 7, 2017. A list of the winners will also be posted at <u>www.GreenvilleSoilandWater.com</u>.

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

One First Place Winner will be selected. The First Place winner will receive a \$150 check. One Second Place winner will be selected and will receive a \$100 check. One Third Place winner will be selected and will receive a \$50 check. Winners will also be honored at the Greenville County Soil and Water Conservation District Awards Gala on May 14, 2020.

Decisions of the judges will be final.
